LEADS Daily Briefing for November 13, 2019

Temporary DL/PID Response

When a new drivers license or photo ID is issued by SOS during the new design rollout, the applicant receives a temporary paper document while the applicant's identity is confirmed (see the 051716 Daily Briefing). Once the application is processed by the Central Issuance production facility, the actual DL or PID will be mailed to the applicant. The duration period for the temporary paper document will always be 90 days.

The fact that the temporary paper document has been issued will now be reflected in the TDL/TIP line of the DL/PID response (in blue in the below examples) and the temporary paper document's duration will be reflected in the new TEMP line located at near the bottom of the DL response (in red in the below example). The PID response does not have this TEMP line since no enforcement action would be taken on a PID's expired temporary paper document.
