USE OF CMC/30 SEXUALLY VIOLENT PREDATOR IN CSO/S AND P SEX OFFENDER RECORDS

Agencies entering Sex Offender records should NOT use MKE/EXSC (Sex Offender Enter – Caution) with CMC/30 Sexually Violent Predator for CSO/P or S offenders. Using CMC/30 flags the offender as a sexually violent predator in both LEADS and NCIC in error. The Illinois State Police Offender Registration Unit will have the necessary documentation to make a determination if an offender is considered sexually violent and will modify a record if needed.

For CSO/P or S offenders, agencies should enter as MKE/EXS without a CMC unless Caution is needed for other reasons, i.e., Armed and Dangerous when EXSC may be used with the appropriate CMC code that describes the reason for caution.
