LEADS System Station Allowances

The LEADS system has a limited number of product/license keys to issue for the OpenFox Messenger client. Therefore, stations which have never been activated (do not show any traffic sent or received) or have not shown any traffic in the past six months will be deleted from all applications.

We apologize, but due to the large amount of stations deleted, it is impossible for LEADS Administration staff to contact individual agencies identifying what station(s) have been inactivated. If station(s) were inactivated for your agency and believe it is important for the station(s) to be re-activated, and they will be used immediately, your LAC will need to submit the Additional Data Device Form found at <https://isp.illinois.gov/LawEnforcement/Forms>.

For security reasons agencies must ensure the need for the station when they are requested, and that the stations be activated/operational within 30 days of assignment. It has been discovered some agencies like to “have stations on hand” in case they are needed in the future. This is not allowed and takes away available product/license keys for agencies who truly need additional stations.
