IVC Misdemeanor Offenses on Arrest Submissions

As a reminder, IVC Misdemeanor Offenses, other than those listed below, are considered Non-Reportable and should not be reported on the arrest submission. Non-Reportable offenses <u>do not</u> post to the Illinois rap sheet. Agencies should continue to report <u>all Felony</u> IVC offenses. Please consult 20 ILCS 2630/5 for more detail. Here are the following traffic misdemeanor offenses we do post to the Illinois rap sheet:

- 625 ILCS 5.0/4's (Anti-Theft Laws)
- 625 ILCS 5.0/3-707 (Operating an uninsured motor vehicle)
- 625 ILCS 5.0/3-708 (Operating under Suspension No Insurance)
- 625 ILCS 5.0/3-710 (Display of false insurance card)
- 625 ILCS 5.0/5-401.3's (Fail to Keep Records/Scrap Processors)
- 625 ILCS 5.0/6-303's (All Driving While License Suspended)
- 625 ILCS 5.0/11-204.1 (Aggravated Fleeing or Eluding)
- 625 ILCS 5.0/11-501's (All DUI's)
- 625 ILCS 5.0/11-502's (All Illegal Poss. Liquor and Cannabis)
- 625 ILCS 5.0/11-503's (Reckless Driving)
- 625 ILCS 40.0/5-7's (Operating a snowmobile under the influence)
- 625 ILCS 45.0/5-16's (Operating a watercraft under the influence)
