Adding Alias Names to Missing Juvenile Records

The National Center for Missing and Exploited Children (NCMEC) has determined that the entry of the mother's maiden name with the juvenile's given first name as an alias has been beneficial in locating missing children, and children kidnapped by a non-custodial mother. There have been recoveries of missing juveniles enrolled in school under the mother's maiden name, and runaway juveniles who have used their mother's maiden surname.

Example:

Master Record Name: Webster, David J. Alias: Pierce, David J.

Enter the juvenile's given last and first name as the master name.

Enter the juvenile's mother's maiden surname, and juvenile's given first name as an alias.
