NextGen Offender

Record Management System Go-Live

The NextGen Offender (NGO) record management system go-live implementation will <u>begin</u> at 5:30PM on Monday, August 25th and complete at 8:00AM on August 26th, 2025.

Beginning at 5:30PM on August 25th, all LEADS services will be off lined and unavailable for 30 minutes. Modification (enter, modify, clear, cancel, supplemental) of Sex Offender (SO) and Violent Offender Against Youth (VOAY) records will be unavailable and will remain inaccessible until the implementation completes.

At 6:00PM on August 25th, all other LEADS services will resume. LEADS inquiry transactions (QXS, Z2, Z5) will continue to search and return all files, including SO and VOAY records. Modification of all other hot files (warrants, protection orders, stolen vehicles, etc.) will be functional.

On August 26th at 8:00AM, the NextGen Offender system will be online and ready for use. At that time, <u>Full Access users</u> will be required to log off and shutdown LEADS Desktop/Messenger, relaunch the program and log on to ensure NGO is installed and available via LEADS Desktop.
