Entry of Drivers Licenses into the Stolen Article File


Due to the fact that Illinois DLN's/Photo IDs are now a unique identifier, lost or stolen Illinois drivers licenses/photo IDs may now be entered into the stolen article file using the DLN/Photo ID as the serial number. The TYP code should be IDRIVER for drivers licenses and ICREDEN for photo ID cards. As a lost/stolen credential, DLs/Photo IDs may be entered into LEADS and NCIC (MKE/LEA).

Inquiry

A check of the article file will not automatically occur when making a drivers license/photo ID inquiry. Instead, a separate inquiry into the article file must be made.

To see if an Illinois DL/Photo ID has been entered as lost/stolen, use the Universal Inquiry Format and enter the DLN/Photo ID in the SER field of the Article section and IDRIVER in the TYP code field for drivers licenses and ICREDEN for photo ID cards.
