NIBRS Data Reports Training

The Illinois-Uniform Crime Reporting (I-UCR) Program will be offering NIBRS training for agencies submitting data to the State NIBRS repository. This training will be an overview of how to access and export NIBRS and Illinois-specific reports. There are certain reports in the NIBRS repository that are already created to show specific data elements. These reports contain searchable parameters based upon the data submitted by the participating NIBRS agency and are designed to show crime patterns, trends, and information on victims, offenders, and arrestees. They also provide data for certain grant funding. This training will cover what data is captured by each report and how it is displayed to allow agencies to access NIBRS and Illinois-specific reports. The training will be offered via WebEx and will be approximately 60-90 minutes.
