

LEADS Daily Briefing for March 25, 2019

SOS Driver's License Response - Telescopic Nighttime Training Permit

The Telescopic Nighttime Training Permit allows a person using vision aid arrangements other than standard eyeglasses or contact lenses to operate a motor vehicle between sunset and 10:00 p.m. for a period of 6 months, provided they are accompanied by a person holding a valid driver's license without nighttime operation restrictions. The driver's hard card will have restrictions F, G, J14 (daytime privileges only), however the permit in their possession allows special restricted nighttime driving privileges. The driver must have the permit in their possession to be valid.
