LEADS Daily Briefing for March 22, 2019

Stolen Article Entry - Illinois Tollway I-PASS

Stolen I-PASS transponders should be entered into LEADS only (MKE/LEA1) unless there are extenuating circumstances or interstate travel is a definite factor. The model (MOD) should be IPASS, the brand (BRA) should be I TOLL (letter I, space, TOLL) for Illinois Tollway, and the type (TYP) should be ETRANSP for transponder. The number indicated in the serial number field (SER) should be the transponder's serial number and NOT the user's I-PASS account number. "Illinois Tollway I-PASS transponder" should be indicated in the MIS.

Here is an example entry:

Agencies who have I-PASS transponders currently entered in a different manner should modify their entries to match the above example.

If you're not sure whether your agency has any I-PASS transponders currently in the system, you may verify this by performing a summary inquiry using the Summary Inquiry format. (LEADS 2000 > Inquiry > Summary Inquiries then select LZA9 as your message key and enter ALL in the DAY field.)

To inquire on an I-PASS transponder, from the LEADS 2000 Universal Inquiry format, enter the serial number of the transponder in the Articles SER field and ETRANSP as the type (TYP) code.
