ADDRESS ENTRY AND MAPPING FOR SEX OFFENDER (SOR) AND MURDERER/VIOLENT OFFENDER AGAINST YOUTH (MVOAY) RECORDS

Address entry in the NextGen SOR Admin system directly correlates with how the address is mapped on the SOR website. Users must utilize all appropriate fields in the address editor area properly in order to ensure accurate offender mapping. Please see the NextGen SOR & MVOAY Training manual for information on all fields within the Address Editor box.

The following rules for address entry have been added to the manual and will assist with mapping offenders.

- Prefix field – use the drop-down menu for any of the following road types:



Prefix

COUNTY ROAD

MILE MARKER

MILE POST

RURAL ROUTE

STAR ROUTE

STATE HIGHWAY

US HIGHWAY

US ROUTE

- Street Name (SNA) field – use only the Street Name or Number in this field. Do NOT precede the name or number with anything in the SNA field. Examples:

- Suffix field – used to define the road classification: ST, AVE, PL, PKWY, etc.

If a user is unsure that an address will map properly, it is recommended that they use Google maps to verify how the address appears.

NOTE: the SOR/MVOAY mapping system updates hourly, so changes may not be seen immediately.
