## Management Control Agreement

In a situation where a non-criminal justice government agency (NCJA) performs criminal justice functions for a criminal justice agency (CJA), the NCJA shall sign and execute a management control agreement (MCA) with the CJA.

The MCA stipulates management control of the criminal justice function remains solely with the CJA. The MCA may be a separate document, or it may be included with the language of an interagency agreement. An example of this scenario is when a city or county IT department provides IT service for a police department.
