

## LEADS Daily Briefing for December 26, 2019

### Service Time Limitation Not Allowed in Warrant Entries

Inclusion of a note in the MIS field or an Add-On of a wanted person entry indicating that service is restricted by a time limitation is not allowed (example: WARRANT EXECUTABLE ONLY DURING COURT HOURS or WARRANT NOT EXECUTABLE ON THE WEEKEND). These time limitations are not issued by a court/judge and therefore not binding on an apprehending agency. Should an ORA not be able to provide transportation when a wanted person is apprehended, that must be indicated as part of the hit confirmation response message. And the detaining agency must then place the appropriate locate on the record.

If your agency receives a hit with a service time limitation notation, the hit should still be confirmed in accordance with LEADS policy (provided your agency is within the GEO limits) and located NOEX if transportation is declined.

Existing wanted person entries with a service time limitation noted in the MIS field or Add-On must be corrected. It is recommended that records be reviewed as they come up for validation and modified accordingly.
