## CHF Gun Entry – Firearms Type Codes

When entering firearms into the LEADS/NCIC Gun File (stolen/missing, recovered, or seized) it is important to ensure that the correct weapon type code (TYP) is being used. Codes for weapon type can be either 1 character or 2-character combination type codes. For example, type code “P” used by itself is the code for a pistol. Type code “I” used by itself is the code for a land mine. Type code “PI” is a 2-character combination code for “pistol, semi-automatic”. The single character codes can have different meanings depending on whether they are entered as a single character code, or as the second character in a combination type code.

Most common firearms entered will require a 2-character combination type code (PI – pistol, semi-automatic, PR – pistol, revolver, SP – shotgun, pump-action, etc.). Also note that type code “Z” is for a weapon that fires electrified darts (a “taser”) and not a generic code or a code to be used for incomplete firearms (i.e.: receiver only – The BATF classifies receivers as firearms, so you would use whatever code would apply if it was a complete gun).

You may refer to the NCIC Code Manual, available via the LEADS 3.0 website, for a full list of gun type codes and combination type codes, as well as firearms manufacturer (MAK) codes.
