Fleet Plates - LIT for Inquiry and Entry

Fleet plates may be issued by the Secretary of State (SOS) to companies who have a fleet of vehicles (example plate below). Previously the issuance of these plates was limited to second division vehicles weighing 8,001 pounds or greater (trucks), but they are now also being issued to rental car companies for display on SUVs and passenger cars.

When inquiring on these plates or entering them into the Computerized Hot Files (CHF), the License Type (LIT) should be ZZ.

Since it is possible that other types of plates issued by SOS could also begin with the letters "FP" (a passenger car plate, for example), when making a CHF entry on a Fleet plate a note should be placed in the MIS field to help clarify (e.g., LIT/FLEET PLATE).
