NCIC Unidentified Persons File

The Unidentified Persons File is made up of computerized records containing information on persons (living or dead) who have been found and whose identity is not known. These records are in NCIC only, not LEADS. There are three kinds of records that may be entered:

Unidentified Deceased - including skeletal remains and recovered body parts.

<u>Unidentified Catastrophe Victim</u> - deceased individual(s) believed to have died as a result of a disaster.

<u>Unidentified Living Person</u> - living person whose identify is not known, who is unable (for whatever reason -medical or physical) to identify him/herself.

Inquiries into the Unidentified Persons file can by made by using the NCIC Missing Person Physical Descriptors inquiry format and the NCIC Unidentified Person Physical Descriptors inquiry format. Both formats are available on the LEADS 2000 Inquiry Menu in the NCIC section.
