Failure to Appear (FTA) Warrants

When a FTA or Contempt of Court for FTA warrant is encountered, agencies are reminded to run a CQR1 and review the criminal history record to determine if the subject had previously been fingerprinted for the original arrest that caused this warrant. If the original arrest was previously reported, the Bureau of Identification (BOI) does not require the subject to be printed a second time. If your agency mandates the subject be printed, please retain this arrest event for internal agency use only and do not transmit these prints to the BOI.

If fingerprints were not submitted for the original arrest, fingerprints should be taken for this warrant and reported to the BOI. This warrant arrest should only be reported using the statute citation for the original offense with the appropriate arrest type field flagged as an "original arrest warrant". The arrest type field can be located on each line of the arrest charge section of the manual arrest fingerprint card. If you report via Livescan, the arrest type field is contained within the arrest segment 2.344 of the electronic fingerprint submission specification Type 2 format.
