SOS 7 Day Temporary Registration Permit

A 7-Day Temporary Registration Permit is a multiple permit for use as a non-resident, drive-away permit or an intrastate permit. The permit may be used for seven days upon issuance and must be operated on empty weight. The permit is issued to licensed transporters and vehicle purchasers who are not Illinois residents. The permit allows a purchaser to reach an out-of-state destination or a transporter movement from the point of origin to the point of destination. It also is issued to allow the movement of unregistered vehicles within the state. The permit is affixed to the upper left rear window of the vehicle being transported.

LEADS Inquiry:

When inquiring on the 7 day permit number, license type (LIT) TM is used. The permit number can be inquired on with or without the leading zeros. For example, 000000124 can be inquired on as LIC/124, LIT/TM since the SOS system will insert leading zeros and return a response.

NOTE: The literal translation for the Status Code field content is identified in the Description field.

LEADS CHF Entry:

The entry of a stolen temporary registration permit into CHF will be handled in the same manner as temporary Illinois license plates, meaning they will be entered into the Stolen License plate file. Since only one permit is issued, entry should occur in both LEADS and NCIC (LEL - complete set).
