2025 Law Enforcement Employee Data

Each year the national Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) Program collects information on the number of full-time law enforcement personnel employed within participating agencies. At this time, the FBI is requesting counts on the number of officer and civilian employees on each department's payroll <u>as of October 31, 2025.</u> To ensure correct employee data are maintained by the national UCR Program, please reference the attached PDF guide. Agencies can begin reporting the data on November 1, 2025 on through the illinois.nibrs.com.

Receipt of individual counts will ensure that each agency is accurately represented, and that all data can be processed and included in the annual publications, *Crime in the United States* and *Law Enforcement Officers Killed and Assaulted* (*LEOKA*). Please note, in the *LEOKA* publication, state and national officer assault data represent only those agencies for which both an annual police employee count and 12 months officer assault data were reported.

Police employee data are now used in the National Use of Force data collection and are a contributing factor in publication determination.

Please provide the 2025 police employee counts to the national Program by December 31st, 2025. Data must be entered into the INR production site (illinois.nibrs.com). Thank you for your assistance and your continued participation in the national UCR Program.
