Civil Capias Writs

Civil capias writs (better known as "body attachments") and warrants relating to civil cases may be entered into LEADS. However, certain entry criteria must be met. Specifically, the civil capias writ and warrants must be:

- 1. directed to all peace officers in Illinois, and
- 2. there must be bonding provisions.

Since a capias is an order by the court for a "body attachment" (hence the nickname) relating to a civil matter and is usually directed to the sheriff of a specific county and not every peace officer in the state, not all capias writs are eligible to be entered into LEADS. Be sure the "body attachment" contains the above two criteria before entering into LEADS. See the eManual, Wanted Persons chapter, Entry of Civil Capias writs topic.
