## **NIBRS Transition Deadline**

If your agency is currently submitting UCR summary data through the iClear summary reporting site, please be aware this site will sunset on <u>December 31, 2022</u>. After that date, the I-UCR program will <u>only</u> accept National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS) reporting.

The I-UCR Program has posted the latest version of the NIBRS User Manual, version date 4/2021, and is available at <a href="https://isp.illinois.gov/CrimeReporting/NIBRS">https://isp.illinois.gov/CrimeReporting/NIBRS</a>. Most questions regarding Incident Based Reporting can be found in this user guide.

To obtain access to the Illinois NIBRS Repository Test site (INRT) [http://iltest.nibrs.com] and begin your transition please send an email to ISP.UCR.Access@illinois.gov.

To become certified by the FBI, agencies must successfully submit three (3) consecutive months of data to the INRT with an error rate of 4% or less. Agencies will have three options to upload their crime reporting data: manual entry (User Interface), XML manual upload, and through XML web services (machine to machine).
