

LEADS Daily Briefing for June 11, 2019

Vehicle Entry Assistance

Making a vehicle entry on a passenger car is a pretty common task, but what about entering a stolen twin engine Cessna or motorized wheelchair? Remember, assistance may be found in the LEADS eManual. Expand the Vehicle chapter and select the Vehicle Type Index (yellow card). Then select the category for the vehicle being entered.

Vehicle Type Index

Click on the Vehicle Type to go to the details.

AIRCRAFT
Private, Commercial, Military, Helicopters, Gliders, Blimps

ALL-TERRAIN
Vehicles that do not fit any other category and are designed to be driven over rough, difficult terrain

ASSEMBLED AUTOMOBILE
Homemade or Rebuilt

AUTOMOBILE
Passenger Cars, SUVs, Light-Duty Trucks, or Vans

CAMPERS FOR TRUCK MOUNTING
Serialized Shell Campers and all other serialized campers designed for truck mounting

CONSTRUCTION EQUIPMENT
Cranes, Forklifts, Graders, Street and Highway Equipment, Bulldozers, Earth-Moving Equipment

The Codes and Sample Enter page for that vehicle type will list the codes to enter in the VMA (vehicle make), VMO (vehicle model), and VST (vehicle style) fields.

MIS	Required	First data item must be the manufacturer's name, followed by model no. and/or model name. If homemade, indicate 'VMA/HOMEMADE'. If not homemade, DONT ENTER the vehicle if the manufacturer's name cannot be determined.
