

## LEADS Daily Briefing for August 14, 2019

### Missing/Wanted Person Supplemental Data

NCIC allows for entry of supplemental identifiers (i.e. LIC, VIN, SMT and SOCs) to be added to NCIC person records. Agencies have always had the capability to directly attach these identifiers to their Missing Persons records; however, attaching supplemental identifiers to Wanted Persons records could only be accomplished by the LEADS Integrated Help Desk at the request of the agency.

LEADS programming enhancements make it possible for agencies to attach supplemental identifiers to NCIC Wanted Person records themselves. These attachments are accomplished by using the Missing Wanted Person Supplemental Data format.

Agencies may also use the Missing/Wanted Person Supplemental Data Format to attach additional alias names, over and above the 30 allowed by LEADS, to the NCIC portion of their wanted person entry. (NOTE: The first 30 alias names are entered using the LEADS Alias format. All additional alias names are attached using the Mission/Wanted Person Supplemental Data Format.)

Modifications have been made to the LEADS eManual, Wanted Person chapter, [Supplemental Record Data](#), to include this new capability through LEADS.

Keep in mind, supplemental data may only be attached to Wanted or Missing person records that have been entered in NCIC and the data will only appear in the NCIC record.

It is highly recommended that previous CHF records entered whereby additional LICs, VINs, SMTs, SOC's, etc. were NOT entered as a Supplemental record, be modified at the time of validation for that record to include a Supplemental record with the additional identifiers.
