FOID Emails to Agencies

As agencies may be aware, the Illinois State Police – Firearms Services Bureau has begun sending notifications to LEOs that are registered with the ISP FSB Criminal Justice Portal --- the same interface where previously Conceal Carry License (CCL) objections were filed. As a result of HB562, a number of improvements were added, such as the ability for registered users to enter and mark FOID cards as surrendered or destroyed as well as directly upload FOID Card & Firearm Disposition Record. As part of these changes, registered users will be emailed a notice (see example below) upon initial revocation/suspension of a FOID or CCL card, and every 14 days thereafter until the individual is brought into compliance with Section 9.5 of the FOID Act. Please be aware the FOID License ID is not the same as the individual's FOID number but is searchable in the Criminal Justice Portal.


