ILLINOIS STATE POLICE MAKES ARREST FOR FIRST DEGREE MURDER IN EXPRESSWAY SHOOTING

CHICAGO – Illinois State Police (ISP) Division of Criminal Investigation Zone 1 East Violent Crimes Unit charged 20-year-old Sean Richardson of Chicago, IL with three counts of First-Degree Murder (Class M Felony) and three counts of Attempted First-Degree Murder (Class X Felony).

On February 19, 2023, at approximately 10:27 p.m., ISP was notified of an expressway shooting that occurred on Interstate 57 northbound at 116th Street in Chicago, IL. Troopers arrived on scene and located two males in the rear of the victim vehicle deceased. The driver and three juveniles were transported to a local hospital with gunshot wounds. The 2-year-old juvenile was later pronounced deceased at the hospital.

After an extensive ISP investigation, the suspect was identified as Richardson. On August 19, 2024, Richardson was arrested by the Chicago Police Department on an unrelated charge. ISP presented the case to the Cook County State's Attorney's Office and the above-mentioned charges were filed. Richardson is being held pending his first court appearance. No further information is available.

The charges are not evidence against the defendant, and the defendant is presumed innocent until proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt in a court of law.
