<u>ILLINOIS STATE POLICE ARRESTS CHICAGO MAN FOR</u> <u>EXPRESSWAY SHOOTING</u>

CHICAGO – Illinois State Police (ISP) Division of Criminal Investigation Zone 1 arrested 37year-old Terrence Robinson of Chicago, IL, for Aggravated Discharge of a Firearm (Class 1 Felony).

On May 30, 2024, at approximately 1:05 a.m., ISP responded to the report of an expressway shooting on the Dan Ryan Expressway, Interstate 94 southbound near 120th Street. The suspect, later identified as Robinson, fired a weapon at the victim's vehicle. The victim's vehicle was struck, but the victim was not injured.

On September 26, 2024, the United States Marshalls Service Great Lakes Regional Fugitive Task Force located Robinson and took him into custody. ISP presented the case to the Cook County State's Attorney's Office and the above-mentioned charge was filed. Robinson is being held at the Chicago Police Department 4th District pending his first court appearance. No further information is available.

The charge is not evidence against the defendant, and the defendant is presumed innocent until proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt in a court of law.
