ILLINOIS STATE POLICE INVESTIGATION LEADS TO ARREST OF CHICAGO MAN FOR LEAVING THE SCENE OF A PERSONAL INJURY CRASH

CHICAGO – An Illinois State Police (ISP) Division of Criminal Investigation Zone 1 investigation led to the arrest of 35-year-old Karris A. Turner of Chicago, IL, for Leaving the Scene of a Personal Injury Crash (Class 2 Felony).

On August 11, 2024, ISP Troop 3 officers responded to a multi-vehicle crash with injuries on I-94 northbound express lanes at 43rd Street. Upon arrival troopers discovered the driver of a gray Hyundai, one of the vehicles involved in the crash, had fled the scene. After an extensive investigation Turner was identified as the driver of the gray Hyundai. ISP agents attempted to locate Turner but were unsuccessful.

On October 1, 2024, a warrant was issued for Turner's arrest and on November 30, 2024, Turner was taken into custody by the Chicago Police Department during a traffic stop. The Cook County State's Attorney approved the above-mentioned charge and Turner is being held at the Chicago Police Department until his first court hearing.

The charge is not evidence against the defendant, and the defendant is presumed innocent until proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt in a court of law.
