<u>ILLINOIS STATE POLICE ARRESTS CHICAGO MAN FOR</u> <u>WEEKEND SHOOTING</u>

CHICAGO – Illinois State Police (ISP) Division of Criminal Investigation Zone 1 arrested 32year-old Reginald Brown from Chicago, IL for Aggravated Possession of a Weapon by a Felon (Class X Felony) and Aggravated Fleeing to Elude (Class 4 Felony). The charges stem from an expressway shooting on January 31, 2025, at approximately 11:10 p.m.

On the above-mentioned date and time, ISP officers responded to a non-injury expressway shooting on Interstate 94 northbound express lanes near 47th Street in Chicago. On February 1, 2025, a suspect vehicle was identified and located on Interstate 94 southbound near 91st Street. A traffic stop was attempted but the vehicle failed to stop. ISP units pursued the vehicle and with assistance from a Chicago Police Department helicopter, the vehicle was seen parking in the 2100 block of 98th Place in Chicago. Brown surrendered to authorities and was taken into custody.

The Cook County State's Attorney's Office approved the above-mentioned charges against Brown. Additional charges are pending. There is no further information.

The charges are not evidence against the defendant, and the defendant is presumed innocent until proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt in a court of law.
