ILLINOIS STATE POLICE SEEKS PUBLIC'S ASSISTANCE IN PEDESTRIAN DEATH INVESTIGATION IN HENRY COUNTY

EAST MOLINE – The Illinois State Police (ISP) Division of Criminal Investigation (DCI) Zone 2 requests the public's assistance with the death investigation of a pedestrian found deceased in the roadway.

On October 16, 2025, ISP Troop 2 responded to a report of a pedestrian struck on I-80 westbound, near milepost 18 in Henry County. The individual was discovered deceased and is believed to have been struck by a vehicle. The individual has not been officially identified and the vehicle that struck the person has not been located.

ISP is seeking information from any motorist traveling in the area of I-80 near milepost 18 on October 16, during the approximate times of 12:00 a.m. to 12:15 a.m.
