ILLINOIS STATE POLICE ASSISTING IN SEARCH FOR SUSPECT IN SHOOTING OF A GRANITE CITY POLICE OFFICER

GRANITE CITY – The Illinois State Police (ISP) is assisting in the search of 26-year-old DJ Marshall of Granite City, IL, believed to have shot a Granite City Police Department officer.

On December 5, 2025, at approximately 2:19 p.m., Granite City Police Department officers responded to a call in the 2000 block of Johnson Road in Granite City. When officers arrived and encountered Marshall, he pulled out a firearm, fired several shots, striking one officer, and fled on foot. The officer was taken to an area hospital and is in stable condition. ISP, utilizing K9 and an aircraft, is working with the Granite City Police Department, Madison County Sheriff's Office, local law enforcement, and the FBI to search for Marshall. Marshall is considered to be armed and dangerous. If you see Marshall, do not engage and call 911 immediately.
