ILLINOIS STATE POLICE ARREST MAN FOR AGGRAVATED BATTERY INVOLVING GREAT BODILY HARM TO A SENIOR CITIZEN

Des Plaines, IL – The Illinois State Police (ISP) Division of Criminal Investigations (DCI) Violent Crimes Unit (VCU) Zone 1 Agents arrested Joquan M. Davis, 23-year old male of Chicago, IL for Aggravated Battery involving Great Bodily Harm to a Senior Citizen (Class 2 Felony).

On February 7, 2022, at approximately 11:30 a.m., ISP District Chicago Troopers responded to a report of an aggravated battery that occurred on the ramp of Interstate 90 northbound at Belmont Avenue. The senior adult victim was attacked while working as a ride share driver. The victim was transported to a local area hospital.

After a thorough and complete investigation, ISP Zone 1 Agents identified, Davis, as a suspect. On May 12, 2022, the Cook County State’s Attorney’s Office approved one count of Aggravated Battery involving Great Bodily Harm to a Senior Citizen. Bond court hearing for Davis is set for May 13, 2022.
