ILLINOIS STATE POLICE ARRESTS CHICAGO MAN FOR ATTEMPTED MURDER IN ROAD RAGE SHOOTING

CHICAGO – The Illinois State Police (ISP) Division of Criminal Investigation Zone 1 arrested 31-year-old Lamont Ross of Chicago, IL for Attempted Murder (Class X Felony) stemming from a recent road rage incident.

On March 31, 2024, ISP Troop 3 responded to a crash and expressway shooting on Interstate 290 eastbound at Racine Avenue. The victim was driving on the entrance ramp from Independence Blvd. to Interstate 290 eastbound when his vehicle was shot at by the suspect. Both vehicles then continued onto I-290 but crashed near Racine Avenue, and the suspect fired again at the victim. The suspect fled on foot. Responding ISP troopers engaged in a foot pursuit but the suspect was able to avoid immediate capture. The victim was not shot, but was transported to an area hospital with non-life-threatening injuries suffered during the traffic crash.

After a thorough investigation, Lamont Ross was identified as the suspect. ISP agents took Ross into custody on April 3, 2024. Ross is charged with Attempted Murder.
