ILLINOIS STATE POLICE MAKES ARREST FOR FIRST DEGREE MURDER IN EXPRESSWAY SHOOTING

CHICAGO – Illinois State Police (ISP) Division of Criminal Investigation Zone 1 East Violent Crimes Unit arrested a 17-year-old juvenile of Lynwood, IL., and charged them with one count of First-Degree Murder (Class M Felony).

On March 16, 2024, at approximately 6:09 p.m., ISP was notified of a traffic crash that occurred at Interstate 94 northbound at 170th Street in Lansing, IL. Troopers arrived on scene and located the driver of a crashed blue Infiniti SUV, who had sustained a gunshot wound stemming from an expressway shooting that had just occurred on Illinois 394 northbound at Thornton Lansing Road in Cook County, IL. The driver was transported to a local hospital where he was pronounced deceased.

After an extensive ISP investigation, the suspect vehicle and a juvenile driver were identified, and a weapon was recovered. On April 11, 2024, the driver was taken into custody. ISP presented the case to the Cook County State's Attorney's Office and the above-mentioned charge was filed. The driver is being held at the Riverdale Police Department pending his first court appearance. No further information is available.

The public is reminded that all persons are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
