ILLINOIS STATE POLICE ARRESTS CHICAGO MAN FOR DAN RYAN EXPRESSWAY SHOOTING

CHICAGO – The Illinois State Police (ISP) Division of Criminal Investigation Zone 1 arrested 29-year-old Marquis Parker of Chicago, IL for Aggravated Battery with a Firearm (Class X Felony).

On April 29, 2022, ISP patrol officers responded to a crash on Interstate 94 northbound near Archer Avenue. Upon arrival officers observed two crashed vehicles and signs of a shooting. The suspects fled the scene before officers arrived. A victim had been shot multiple times and was transported to an area hospital with serious injuries.

After an extensive, nearly two-year long investigation, Marquis Parker was identified as one of the suspects, and he was taken into custody at his residence by the FBI Violent Fugitive Task Force on April 17, 2024. Parker was held at the Cook County Jail pending his first court appearance. Byron Moore was also charged in relation to the shooting and was previously taken into custody by ISP on March 19, 2024.
