ILLINOIS STATE POLICE ARRESTS CHICAGO MAN FOR ROAD RAGE RELATED ATTEMPTED MURDER

CHICAGO – Illinois State Police (ISP) Division of Criminal Investigation Zone 1 East Violent Crimes Unit arrested 30-year-old Steven Moore of Chicago, IL. Moore was charged with three counts of Attempted Murder (Class X Felony) stemming from a road rage related expressway shooting.

On April 26, 2024, at approximately 11:08 a.m., ISP was notified of an expressway shooting that occurred on the Interstate 94 northbound ramp to westbound Interstate 290. An occupant in the suspect vehicle fired a weapon, striking the victim vehicle several times. The victim was uninjured, and the suspect fled the scene. After an extensive ISP investigation, the suspect vehicle was identified. The suspect vehicle was located by ISP agents and Moore was taken into custody.

On April 27, 2024, the Cook County State's Attorney's Office approved the above charges against Moore. Moore is being held at the Riverdale Police Department pending a detention hearing.
