ILLINOIS STATE POLICE ARRESTS ROCK FALLS MAN FOR DISSEMINATION OF CHILD PORNOGRAPHY

ROCK FALLS – Illinois State Police (ISP) Division of Criminal Investigation Zone 2 announces the arrest of 39-year-old Adam O. Davis of Rock Falls, IL for five counts of Dissemination of Child Pornography (Class X Felony).

On June 6, 2024, after an extensive investigation into the dissemination of child pornography via a computer program, ISP agents executed a search warrant at a residence in the 1400 block of Avenue A in Rock Falls, IL. Evidence of child pornography was gathered as a result of the search warrant and Davis was taken into custody and transported to the Whiteside County Jail.

The Illinois State Police provides resources for parents, for the public to report crimes against children, and victims to start their path towards healing and recovery.
