<u>ILLINOIS STATE POLICE ARREST QUINCY MAN FOR</u> <u>NARCOTICS</u>

QUINCY – Illinois State Police (ISP) Division of Criminal Investigation West Central Illinois Task Force (WCITF) arrested 38-year-old Natas T. Reed of Quincy for Methamphetamine Delivery Over 900 grams (Class X felony).

On July 10, 2024 at approximately 10:10 p.m., WCITF agents, with the assistance of the Quincy Police Department and the Adams County Sheriff's Office, made a traffic stop near 36th and Harrison in Quincy.

During the traffic stop, agents arrested Reed for an Adams County warrant for Aggravated Battery to a pregnant person. During the search of the vehicle, agents found more than 900 grams of ice methamphetamine. Reed was incarcerated at the Adams County Jail.
