ORDER OF THE STATEWIDE 9-1-1 ADMINISTRATOR

WHEREAS, the Proviso-Leyden JETSB submitted a modification plan with the Office of the Statewide 9-1-1 Administrator on June 17, 2019, seeking to opt out the Village of Westchester;

WHEREAS, the modification plan has been read and reviewed by the Department and the Administrator;

WHEREAS, the modification plan seeks to opt out the Village of Westchester into the South West Cook County Consolidated Dispatch ETSB from the Proviso-Leyden JETSB;

WHEREAS, as it relates to "wireline" surcharge monies the Proviso-Leyden JETSB and the South West Cook County Consolidated Dispatch ETSB have entered into an IGA allowing wireline surcharge monies to be paid to the South West Cook County Consolidated Dispatch ETSB and requiring the South West Cook County Consolidated Dispatch ETSB to account for such monies in its audited annual financial reporting as required under Section 40 of the ETSA, and

WHEREAS, as it relates to "wireless" surcharge monies, Section 30(b)(1)(D) and 30(2)(E) of the ETSA directs the Department to make monthly grants to the appropriate 9-1-1 Authority currently taking wireless 9-1-1 based upon zip code billing of wireless subscribers. Accordingly, the IGA specified the boundary change resulting from Westchester disengaging with the Proviso-Leyden JETSB and consolidating with the South West Cook County Consolidated Dispatch ETSB and specified that the South West Cook County Consolidated Dispatch ETSB will then be responsible to account for such monies in its audited annual financial reporting as required under Section 40 of the ETSA.

NOW THEREFORE, the Administrator orders the following;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Proviso-Leyden JETSB request for approval of its modification plan as follows:

Opting out the Village of Westchester from the Proviso-Leyden JETSB to the South West Cook County Consolidated Dispatch ETSB

pursuant to Title 83: Public Utilities Chapter IV: Department of State Police Part 1325 - Standards of Service Applicable to 9-1-1 Emergency Systems Section 205, is hereby approved subject to the requirements of this Order.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Proviso-Leyden JETSB modification will be completed no later than March 1, 2020.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Proviso-Leyden JETSB's 9-1-1 System Service Provider will conduct a P.01 Study and if necessary a Traffic Study to determine the number of 9-1-1 trunks required to serve the Proviso-Leyden JETSB with the departure of Westchester.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Westchester wireline and wireless surcharge payments currently being distributed to the Proviso-Leyden JETSB shall begin to be distributed to the South West Cook County Consolidated Dispatch ETSB as defined in 50 ILCS 750/30 beginning with the March 2020 remit period.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that South West Cook County Consolidated Dispatch ETSB is responsible for the accounting and audited annual financial reporting for Westchester's wireline and wireless surcharge monies.
