Will County has since consolidated to three PSAPS; Laraway Comm. Center, Joliet and Wescom. Since the consolidation, it was necessary for the backup configuration to be modified. AT&T will need to add two 9-1-1 trunks from the Geneva selective router to Wescom. This will not only allow Wescom to provide backup services to the Joliet PSAP, but will allow Wescom to handle all 9-1-1 calls form the Blue Island, Lombard and Geneva selective routers for the Laraway Comm. Center. This will reduce the need for Joliet to provide backup services to Laraway for just the Geneva selective router. Then the existing trunks from the Geneva router to Joliet can then be disconnected. The Laraway Comm. Center will provide backup PSAP services to Wescom in return.
