**Application for 9-1-1
Modification Plan**

ORDER OF THE STATEWIDE 9-1-1 ADMINISTRATOR

WHEREAS, the Cook County 9-1-1 System submitted a modification plan with the Office of the Statewide 9-1-1 Administrator on March 14, 2019, seeking to opt in the Village of Indian Head Park;

WHEREAS the modification plan has been read and reviewed by the Department and the Administrator; and

WHEREAS the modification plan seeks to opt in the Village of Indian Head Park into the Cook County 9-1-1 System;

WHEREAS as it relates to "wireline" surcharge monies the Southwest Central Joint ETSB and the Cook County ETSB have entered into an IGA allowing wireline surcharge monies to be paid to Cook County and requiring Cook County to account for such monies in its audited annual financial reporting as required under Section 40 of the ETSA.

WHEREAS as it relates to "wireless" surcharge monies, Section 30(b)(1)(D) and 30(2)(E) of the ETSA directs the Department to make monthly grants to the appropriate 9-1-1 Authority currently taking wireless 9-1-1 based upon zip code billing of wireless subscribers. Accordingly, the IGA specified the boundary change resulting from Indian Head Park disengaging with Southwest Central and consolidating with Cook County and specified that Cook County will then be responsible to account for such monies in its audited annual financial reporting as required under Section 40 of the ETSA.

WHEREAS Cook County and Indian Head Park have entered into an IGA concerning the payment of 9-1-1 surcharge, the financial reporting and auditing of the funds, and other specifics concerning the addition of Indian Head Park to the Cook County ETSB.

NOW THEREFORE, the Administrator orders the following;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Cook County 9-1-1 System request for approval of its modification plan as follows:

Opting in the Village of Indian Head Park from the Southwest Central 9-1-1 System to the Cook County 9-1-1 System

pursuant to Section 15.4a of the Emergency Telephone System Act, 50 ILCS 750/15.4a, is hereby approved subject to the requirements of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Cook County modification will be completed no later than April 30, 2019.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Cook County's 9-1-1 System Service Provider will conduct a P.01 Study and if necessary, a Traffic Study to determine the number of 9-1-1 trunks required to serve the Cook County 9-1-1 System with the addition of Indian Head Park.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Cook County 9-1-1 System will file with the Administrator a Wireless 9-1-1 Plan that adds Indian Head Park to their current Plan with an effective date no later than May 1, 2019.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Indian Head Park surcharge payments currently being distributed to the Southwest Central 9-1-1 System shall begin to be distributed to the Cook County 9-1-1 System as defined in 50 ILCS 750/30 beginning May 1, 2019.


