INTRODUCTION

- 2) Reduction in 9-1-1 trunks from the selective router to the PSAP
- 3) Further reduction of PSAPs within a 9-1-1 Authority beyond consolidation as required by the Act

Plan Narrative:

The Cook County ETSB has provided 911 for the Village of Dixmoor since 1997. The Village of Dixmoor entered into an agreement for dispatching services through CALCOMM. Currently when the citizens dial 911 they are being routed to the Cook County PSAP which is is then transferring the call back to the Village of Dixmoor for police/fire dispatching. By routing calls directly to CALCOMM this will eliminate a 911 transfer and also save time for the caller which will be routed to the dispatch center. Once the modification plan is approved, AT&T will issue the network drawing showing Dixmoor removed from the Cook County system.

There are no changes to the adjacent agencies or participating agenices section as any transfers to Dixmoor will be an actual transfer.

FIVE YEAR STRATEGIC PLAN FOR MODIFIED PLAN

Narrative:

In anticipation of future consolidations, the Cook County Emergency Telephone System Board and the Cook County Sheriff's Police Office began expanding 911 operations in July 2015. Currently the main center in Des Plaines has 32 positions. This includes 25 full dispatcing, 4 call taking positions and 3 postions that are built and waiitng for computer equipment.

The Maywood backup center, which was renovated in 2017, has 18 dispatch positions.

The design of the Cook County next generation capable phone system from Zetron is unique in that it provides redundancy with a full independent system at the primary site and the backup site. The system allows operators to select which controller they are using which essentially allows the backup center to work simultaneously with the primary site. This increases the active call postions to 48 operator positions.

The center has made significant investments in its infrastructure over the past 5 years. This has prepared the center to accept new consolidations over the next few years without passing along the cost of technology or infrastruture to its constract dispatch agencies.

AGREEMENT RELATING TO THE TRANSFER AND REPORTING OF SURCHARGE FUNDS RELATING TO THE VILLAGE OF DIXMOOR, ILLINOIS

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, section 15.4a of the Emergency Telephone System Act 50ILCS 750/1 et seq. (the "Act") requires any Authority, as defined by the Act, in a county with a population of 250,000, to consolidate such that no 911-Authority in the county serves a population of less than 25,000; and

WHEREAS, Calumet Park Regional Joint 911 ETSB operates CalComm 911 for certain municipalities; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the act Cook County ETSB includes the Village of Dixmoor, along with other municipalities and unincorporated areas of Cook County; and

A

WHEREAS, pursuant to 50 ILCS 15.4 (a) (2), the Village of Dixmoor requested that it be included in the Calumet Park Regional Joint ETSB, and the Calumet Park Regional Joint ETSB has agreed to accept the Village of Dixmoor into their 911 system; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the bylaws adapted by the Cook County ETSB, the Village of Dixmoor has provided notice of its intended termination in the Cook County ETSB; and

WHEREAS, to facilitate the Village of Dixmoor's transition to the Calumet Park Joint Regional ETSB, the parties desire to enter into this Agreement to confirm their understanding that the Village of Dixmoor will cease to be a member of the Cook County ETSB, and will become a member of the Calumet Park Regional Joint 911 ETSB; that, thereafter the boundaries for 911 calls for each party will change such that 911 emergency calls originating in the Village of Dixmoor will be handled by the Calumet Park Regional Joint ETSB.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises and mutual covenants hereafter set forth, the parties agree as follows:

Section1. Incorporation of Recitals

The foregoing preambles are hereby incorporated into this Agreement as if fully restated in this Section 1.

Section 2. Village Opt-Out

The Village of Dixmoor has provided notice required by Cook County ETSB's by-laws to terminate its status as a Cook County ETSB member municipality and upon approval of Calumet Park Regional Joint ETSB's plan by the State of Illinois' Office of the Statewide 911 Administrator, Village of Dixmoor shall become a member of the Calumet Park Regional Joint ETSB.

Section 3. Wireless Call Boundaries

Upon Village of Dixmoor becoming a Calumet Park Regional Joint ETSB member municipality, the wireless call boundaries of Calumet Park Regional Joint ETSB and Cook County ETSB shall change, such that all wireless 911 calls originating within the Village of Dixmoor shall no longer be handled by Cook County ETSB, and instead shall be handled by Calumet Park Regional Joint ETSB.

Section 4. Funds

Once the consolidation plan is approved by the State of Illinois' Office of the Statewide 911 Administrator, Calumet Park Regional Joint ETSB shall receive all wireline funds attributable to the Village of Dixmoor in accordance with the "Act." Calumet Park Regional Joint ETSB will be responsible for all funds it receives and for the reporting and auditing of all funds as described in Section 5 below.

Section 5. Financial Reporting of Funds

Cook County ETSB shall be responsible for all required reporting relating to any funds, including the financial report required by Section 40 of the Act, up to and including the date that Calumet Park Regional Joint ETSB's consolidation plan is approved by the State of Illinois' Office of the Statewide 911 Administrator. Thereafter Calumet Park Regional Joint ETSB shall be responsible for all such reporting.

Section 6. Term

The term of this agreement shall commence on the date the last signatory hereto signs ("Effective Date") and shall end as of the date upon which Cook County ETSB files the

last financial report relating to any wireline funds attributable to the Village required by Section 5 hereof.

Section 7. Counterparts

This Agreement may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed to be an original and both of which shall constitute one and the same Agreement.

Section 8. Severability

If any part of this Agreement is held invalid for any reason, the remainder of this Agreement shall remain valid to the maximum extent possible.

Section 9. Governing Law

This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Illinois without giving consideration to the principles of conflict of laws.

Section 10. Entire Agreement

This Agreement represents the entire agreement between the parties and there are no other promises or conditions in any other agreement whether oral or written.

The Cook County PSAP receiving a call for emergency services in your jurisdiction shall dispatch the call in the following manner:

Primary Telephone transfer via your agency's primary routing number as identified by AT&T. Secondary via your agency's 10-digit emergency number Tertiary ISPERN or point to point radio.

Aid Outside Jurisdiction Boundaries

Once an emergency unit is dispatched in response to a request through the system, such unit shall render its service to the requesting party without regard to whether the unit is operating outside its normal jurisdictional boundaries. The legislative intent is that 9-1-1 be used for emergency calls only. Therefore, all calls of an administrative or non-emergency nature shall be referred to your agency's published telephone number.

The PSAP Center agrees to keep all records, times, and places of all calls. All records will be available to all participants of the 9-1-1 System according to State of Illinois Administrative Rules and internal policy. It shall be the responsibility of your agency to maintain the report of call and the disposition of each call.

There is no need to respond to this notification unless it is your desire to modify this agreement or withdraw from it. Unless we hear from you within ten (10) days, we will assume that agreement remains in full effect. RESOLUTION TO PERMIT THE VILLAGE OF <u>DIXMOOR</u> TO OPT OUT OF THE COOK COUNTY 9-1-1 SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has enacted the Emergency Telephone System Act, 50 ILCS 750/0.01 et seq. ("Act") which enables a county to impose a surcharge on billed subscribers of network connections provided by telecommunications carriers at a rate per network connection in order to implement and maintain a 9-1-1 Emergency Telephone System; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 26-79 of Ordinance Number 01-O-35 of the Cook County Code of Ordinances ("Ordinance"), the Cook County Emergency Telephone System Board ("ETSB") has the authority to plan and implement a 9-1-1 system and receive monies from the surcharge imposed under the Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the ETSB has provided 9-1-1 services to the Village of Dixmoor for many years; and

WHEREAS, the Village of <u>Dixmoor</u> has requested that it be permitted to opt out of the Cook County 9-1-1 System so that it may join the Calumet Park Regional Joint ETSB to minimize call transfers in accordance with Section 15.4b(1) of the Act; and

WHEREAS, the ETSB has agreed to release the Village of <u>Dixmoor</u> from the Cook County 9-1-1 System effective upon approval by the Illinois State Police 9-1-1 Administrator; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that pursuant to a request from the Village of <u>Dixmoor</u>, the ETSB hereby agrees to permit the Village of <u>Dixmoor</u> to opt out of the Cook County 9-1-1 System effective upon approval by the Illinois State Police 9-1-1 Administrator.

ALTERNATE DISPATCHING AGREEMENT

This agreement made and entered into between the Cook County 9-1-1 System (hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY") and the Southwest Central 9-1-1 System (hereinafter referred to as "SOUTHWEST").

WITNESSIGTTI:

WEIBREAS, COUNTY has a fully operational BTS (Emergency Telephone System)

WHEREAS, SOUTOWEST has a fully functional BTS and

WEILBREAS, under Illinois law which an BTS is required to select a location for alternato routing when all 911 lines to the primary Public Safety -Answering Point ("PSAP") are busy or if the primary PSAP closes down for a period of time due to an emergency situation; and

WEBREAS, COUNTY is a PSAP, and

WHBREAS, Article VII, Section 10 of the 1970 Illinois Constitution and Chapter 127, Section 748 of the Illinois Revised Statutes authorized an intergovernmental cooperation association to enter into contract with units of local government, and

WHIRBAS, COUNTY and SOUTHWIST mutually desire to enter into an Agreement establishing SOUTHWHST as the location for alternate routing of 9-1-1 calls as agreed upon in the "Alternate Routing Agreement" and dispatch of EMERCIENCY 9-1-1 calls in the event that COUNTY closes down for period of time due to an emergency situation.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the above premises, and also the mutual covenants contained herein, COUNTY and SOUTHWEST do hereby agree as follows:

When, at any time COUNTY closes down for a period of time, or has to evacuate/relocate due to an Emergency situation and the "Alternate Routing Agreement" has been applied, SOUTHWEST agrees to dispatch any calls that are of an "EMERGENCY" nature until COUNTY personnel relocate to their 9-1-1 Back-up Center located at the Sheriff's Police Headquarters in Maywood, Illinois. SOUTHWEST agrees to dispatch calls as set out above as so far as the resources of SOUTHWEST permit.

2). COUNTY, upon determining that their 911 Center must evacuate/relocate will contact the SOUTHWEST PSAP, advise reason for the alternate routing and provide estimated time of arrival of COUNTY personnel to their back-up center in Maywood, Illinois.

3). COUNTY will provide SOUTHWBST with one (1) contact Patrol Supervisor, rank of Sergeant or higher, assigned to South Area Patrol. COUNTY will provide SOUTHWBST with the call number and alternate phone/cell numbers for the responsible Patrol Supervisor.

4). SOUTHWEST agrees to contact this said Supervisor with any EMBRGENCY calls needing dispatch, transmitting directly on a radio provided by the COUNTY ETSB and located at SOUTHWEST.

5). COUNTY Patrol Supervisor will be responsible for relaying back to SOUTHWEST the call number(s) of the appropriate COUNTY Beat Officer that will respond to the BMBRGBNCY call. SOUTHWEST then agrees to dispatch this officer(s) to the pending BMBRGBNCY call.

6). SOUTHWEST agrees to maintain radio communication, on the equipment provided by the COUNTY ETSB, with any officer responding to or involved in an EMERGENCY situation.

7). Once COUNTY personnel arrive at the 911 Back-up Center located at the Sheriff's Police Headquarters in Maywood, Illinois all communication (phone/radio) will be handled by COUNTY.

8). SOUTHWBST agrees to serve as COUNTY'S backup PSAP without my compensation.

Withdrawal must be in compliance with all applicable rules or requirements of Illinois law and the Illinois Commerce Commission.

11). If the event a Court of proper jurisdiction determines that any paragraph(s) of this Agreement are invalid, the parties agree that such invalidity shall not effect the validity of the remaining portions of this Agreement.

12). This Agreement constitutes the complete, final, and entire Agreement between SOUTHWEST and COUNTY and supercedes any prior agreements, either written or oral, between the parties.

13). Any modifications to this Agreement must be in writing and signed by both COUNTY and SOUTHWEST to be effective.

ALTERNATE AGREEMENT

This agreement made and entered into between the Cook County 9-1-1 System (hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY") and the Northwest Central 9-1-1 System (hereinafter referred to as "NORTHWEST").

WITNESSITTI:

WIBREAS, COUNTY has a fully operational BTS (Rmergency Telephone System)

WHERBAS, NORTHWEST has a fully functional ETS and

WHBRBAS, under Illinois law which an BTS is required to select a location for alternate routing when all 911 lines to the primary Public Safety Answering Point ("PSAP") are busy or if the primary PSAP closes down for a period of time due to an emergency situation; and

WHEREAS, COUNTY is a PSAP, and

WITERBAS, Article VII, Section 10 of the 1970 Illinois Constitution and Chapter 127, Section 748 of the <u>Illinois Revised Statutes</u> authorized an intergovernmental cooperation association to enter into contract with units of local government, and

WHEREAS, COUNTY and NORTHWEST mutually desire to enter into an Agreement establishing NORTHWEST as the location for alternate routing of 9-1-1 calls as agreed upon in the "Alternate Routing Agreement" and dispatch of RMERGENCY 9-1-1 calls in the event that COUNTY closes down for period of time due to an emergency situation.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the above premises, and also the mutual covenants contained herein, COUNTY and NORTHWEST do hereby agree as follows:

1). When, at any time COUNTY closes down for a period of time, or has to evacuate/relocate due to an Emergency situation and the "Alternate Ronting Agreement" has been applied, NORTHWEST agrees to dispatch any calls that are of an "EMBRGBNCY" nature until COUNTY personnel relocate to their 9-1-1 Back-up Conter located at the Sheriff's Police Headquarters in Maywood, Illinois. NORTHWEST agrees to dispatch calls as set out above as so far as the resources of NORTHWEST permit.

2). COUNTY, upon determining that their 911 Center must evacuate/relocate will contact the NORTHWEST PSAP, advise reason for the alternate routing and provide estimated time of arrival of COUNTY personnel to their back-up center in Maywood, Illinois.

3). COUNTY will provide NORTHWEST with one (1) contact Patrol Supervisor, rank of Sergeant or higher, assigned to North Area Patrol. COUNTY will provide NORTHWEST with the call number and alternate phone/cell numbers for the responsible Patrol Supervisor.

4). NORTHWEST agrees to contact this said Supervisor with any EMERGENCY calls riceding dispatch, transmitting directly on a radio provided by the COUNTY ETSB and located at NORTHWEST.

5). COUNTY Patrol Supervisor will be responsible for relaying back to NORTHWEST the call number(s) of the appropriate COUNTY Beat Officer that will respond to the EMBRGENCY call. NORTHWEST then agrees to dispatch this officer(s) to the pending EMBRGENCY call.

6). NORTHWEST agrees to maintain radio communication, on the equipment provided by the COUNTY BTSB, with any officer responding to or involved in an EMBRGENCY situation.

7). Once COUNTY personnel arrive at the 911 Back-up Center located at the SheritPs Police Headquarters in Maywood, Illinois all communication (phone/radio) will be handled by COUNTY.

8). NORTHWEST agrees to serve as COUNTY'S backup PSAP without any compensation.
