ORDER OF THE STATEWIDE 9-1-1 ADMINISTRATOR

WHEREAS, the Vernon Hills Joint 9-1-1 System submitted a modification plan with the Office of the Statewide 9-1-1 Administrator on April 2, 2019, seeking to opt out the Village of Inverness;

WHEREAS the modification plan has been read and reviewed by the Department and the Administrator; and

WHEREAS the modification plan seeks to opt out the Village of Lincolnshire into the Deerfield Consolidated Center 9-1-1 System from the Vernon Hills Joint 9-1-1 System;

WHEREAS as it relates to "wireline" surcharge monies the Vernon Hills Joint 9-1-1 System and the Deerfield Consolidated Center 9-1-1 System have entered into an IGA allowing wireline surcharge monies to be paid to Deerfield and requiring Deerfield to account for such monies in its audited annual financial reporting as required under Section 40 of the ETSA.

WHEREAS as it relates to "wireless" surcharge monies, Section 30(b)(1)(D) and 30(2)(E) of the ETSA directs the Department to make monthly grants to the appropriate 9-1-1 Authority currently taking wireless 9-1-1 based upon zip code billing of wireless subscribers. Accordingly, the IGA specified the boundary change resulting from Lincolnshire disengaging with Vernon Hills and consolidating with Deerfield and specified that Deerfield will then be responsible to account for such monies in its audited annual financial reporting as required under Section 40 of the ETSA.

NOW THEREFORE, the Administrator orders the following:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Vernon Hills Joint 9-1-1 System request for approval of its modification plan as follows:

Opting out the Village of Lincolnshire from the Vernon Hills Joint 9-1-1 System to the Deerfield Consolidated Center 9-1-1 System

pursuant to Title 83: Public Utilities Chapter IV: Department of State Police Part 1325 - Standards of Service Applicable to 9-1-1 Emergency Systems Section 205, is hereby approved subject to the requirements of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Vernon Hills Joint 9-1-1 System modification will be completed no later than August 1, 2019.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Vernon Hills Joint 9-1-1 System 9-1-1 System Service Provider will conduct a P.01 Study and if necessary, a Traffic Study to determine the number of 9-1-1 trunks required to serve the Vernon Hills Joint 9-1-1 System with the departure of Lincolnshire.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Lincolnshire wireline and wireless surcharge payments currently being distributed to the Vernon Hills Joint 9-1-1 System shall begin to be distributed to the Deerfield Consolidated Center 9-1-1 System as defined in 50 ILCS 750/30 beginning with the distribution for the August 2019 remit period.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Deerfield is responsible for the accounting and audited annual financial reporting for Lincolnshire's wireline and wireless surcharge monies.
