# **ORDER OF THE STATEWIDE 9-1-1 ADMINISTRATOR**

**WHEREAS** the Cook County ETSB submitted a modification plan with the Office of the Statewide 9-1-1 Administrator on November 19, 2020, seeking to opt in the City of Park Ridge;

**WHEREAS** the modification plan has been read and reviewed by the Department and the Administrator; and

**WHEREAS** the modification plan seeks to opt in the City of Park Ridge into the Cook County 9-1-1 System from the West Suburban Consolidated Dispatch Center;

WHEREAS as it relates to "wireline" surcharge monies the West Suburban Consolidated Dispatch Center and the Cook County ETSB have entered into an IGA allowing wireline surcharge monies to be paid to Cook County and requiring Cook County to account for such monies in its audited annual financial reporting as required under Section 40 of the ETSA.

WHEREAS as it relates to "wireless" surcharge monies, Section 30(b)(1)(D) and 30(2)(E) of the ETSA directs the Department to make monthly grants to the appropriate 9-1-1 Authority currently taking wireless 9-1-1 based upon zip code billing of wireless subscribers. Accordingly, the IGA specified the boundary change resulting from Park Ridge disengaging with the West Suburban Consolidated Dispatch Center and consolidating with Cook County and specified that Cook County will then be responsible to account for such monies in its audited annual financial reporting as required under Section 40 of the ETSA.

**WHEREAS** Cook County and West Suburban Consolidated Dispatch Center have entered into an IGA concerning the payment of 9-1-1 surcharge, the financial reporting and auditing of the funds, and other specifics concerning the addition of City of Park Ridge to the Cook County 9-1-1 System.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Administrator orders the following;

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the Cook County ETSB's request for approval of its modification plan as follows:

Opting in the City of Park Ridge from the West Suburban Consolidated Dispatch Center to the Cook County 9-1-1 System pursuant to Title 83: Public Utilities Chapter IV: Department of State Police Part 1325 - Standards of Service

Applicable to 9-1-1 Emergency Systems Section 205, is hereby approved subject to the requirements of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Cook County modification will be completed no later than March 1, 2021.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Cook County's 9-1-1 System Service Provider will conduct a P.01 Study and if necessary, a Traffic Study to determine the number of 9-1-1 trunks required to serve the Cook County 9-1-1 System with the addition of Park Ridge.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Cook County 9-1-1 System will file with the Administrator a Wireless 9-1-1 Plan that adds Park Ridge to their current Plan with an effective date no later than February 1, 2021.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Park Ridge surcharge payments currently being distributed to the West Suburban Consolidated Dispatch Center shall begin to be distributed to the Cook County 9-1-1 System as defined in 50 ILCS 750/30 beginning with the distribution of the March 2021 surcharge funds.
