DuPage County ETSB is requesting to decommission and close the DuPage Sheriff's Office PSAP. The Sheriff's PSAP is preparing to close by November 2, 2020. DuPage County Sheriff only took calls for its agency as well as wireless 9-1-1 calls for its geographic area. ACDC will be handling the 9-1-1 calls for the Sheriff's Office and the call handling agreement for those calls has been included. The Sheriff is also entering into a contract with ACDC to handle other dispatching services, but that has not been finalized yet.</p> <p>There is no anticipated change in annual networking costs or revenue with the modification because it is a consolidation within the DuPage ETSB 9-1-1 system. The one-time consolidation cost has been estimated at \$321,446.00. In addition, there will also be a cost to move some of the equipment at the Sheriff's Office to ACDC or DU-COMM.</p>
