**ORDER OF THE STATEWIDE 9-1-1 ADMINISTRATOR**

**WHEREAS**, the Kane County ETSB submitted a modification plan with the Office of the Statewide 9-1-1 Administrator on August 30, 2017, seeking to reduce the number of PSAP's within the ETSB by 50% as required by the Emergency Telephone System Act;

**WHEREAS** the modification plan has been read and reviewed by the Department and the Administrator; and

**WHEREAS** the modification plan seeks to reduce by 1 the number of PSAP's within their ETSB by opting out the City of Aurora and the Village of North Aurora from the Kane County 9-1-1 System and into the Naperville 9-1-1 System;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Administrator orders the following;

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the Kane County ETSB request for approval of its modification plan as follows:

Opting out the City of Aurora and the Village of North Aurora from the Kane County 9-1-1 System to the Naperville 9-1-1 System

pursuant to Section 15.4a of the Emergency Telephone System Act, 50 ILCS 750/15.4a, is hereby approved subject to the requirements of this Order.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Kane County ETSB modification will be completed no later than November 30, 2017.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Kane County ETSB 9-1-1 System Service Provider will conduct a P.01 Study and if necessary a Traffic Study to determine the number of 9-1-1 trunks required to serve the remaining Kane County PSAP's.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Kane County will file with the Administrator a Wireless 9-1-1 Plan to remove Aurora and North Aurora with an effective date no later than November 30, 2017.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Aurora and North Aurora surcharge payments currently being distributed to Kane County shall begin to be distributed to the Naperville ETSB as defined in 50 ILCS 750/30 beginning December 1, 2017.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Kane County ETSB will transfer any reserve fund balance to the Naperville ETSB by December 31, 2017.
