ORDER OF THE STATEWIDE 9-1-1 ADMINISTRATOR

WHEREAS, the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Recommendations of Administrative Law Judge Daniel Faermark in the above-captioned case have been read and examined; and

WHEREAS, the record has been read and reviewed:

WHEREAS, the Statewide 9-1-1 Advisory Board held a hearing on June 19, 2017 on this Request for Consolidation, at which hearing, the Statewide 9-1-1 Advisory Board voted to recommend approval of the Request for Consolidation;

WHEREAS, the rulings of the Administrative Law Judge on admission of evidence and all motions are correct and hereby concurred in by the Administrator; and

WHEREAS, the Administrator finds that the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, as stated in the Recommended Decision, are correct, they are hereby adopted as the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law of the Administrator.

NOW THEREFORE, the Administrator adopts the recommendations as set forth in the Recommended Decision with modifications;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that pursuant to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, as set forth in the Recommended Decision, and upon the advice and recommendation of the Statewide 9-1-1 Advisory Board, the Northeast Lake County Consolidated ETSB Joint ETSB request for approval of its consolidation plan pursuant to Section 15.4a of the Emergency Telephone System Act, 50 ILCS 750/15.4a, is approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Northeast Lake County Consolidated ETSB Joint ETSB consolidation will be completed no later than July 31, 2017.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Northeast Lake County Consolidated ETSB Joint ETSB's 9-1-1 System Service Provider will conduct a P.01 Study and if necessary a Traffic Study to determine the number of 9-1-1 trunks required to serve the Northeast Lake County Consolidated ETSB Joint ETSB in advance of completing the consolidation.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Northeast Lake County Consolidated ETSB Joint ETSB will file with the Administrator a Wireless 9-1-1 Plan to include Gurnee and Zion for all Carriers no later than August 31, 2017 with an effective date no later than September 30, 2017.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Northeast Lake County Consolidated ETSB Joint ETSB shall begin to receive surcharge payments as defined in 50 ILCS 750/30 beginning July 1, 2017.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Gurnee and Zion ETSB's will transfer any reserve fund balance to the Northeast Lake County Consolidated ETSB Joint ETSB by July 1, 2017.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Gurnee and Zion will submit a close out AR-911 Report by August 31, 2017 that will include the reporting of surcharge and other Revenue received and expenditures made since the Most Recent Fiscal Year Ending as Reported on their 2016 AR911 Report through June 30, 2017 when the surcharge is scheduled to be transitioned to the Northeast Lake County Consolidated ETSB Joint ETSB. Failure to do so will result in withholding of surcharge.

This Order is a final administrative decision subject to review under the Administrative Review Law, 735 ILCS 5/3-101 *et seq.* which requires that every action to review such decision shall be commenced by the filing of a complaint and the issuance of summons in the Circuit Court within 35 days from the date that a copy of the decision was served upon the parties.
