**ORDER OF THE STATEWIDE 9-1-1 ADMINISTRATOR**

**WHEREAS**, the Cook County ETSB submitted a modification plan with the Office of the Statewide 9-1-1 Administrator on June 7, 2018, seeking to opt out the Village of Stone Park;

WHEREAS the modification plan has been read and reviewed by the Department and the Administrator; and

WHEREAS the modification plan seeks to opt out the Village of Stone Park into the Proviso-Leyden JETSB from the Cook County ETSB;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Administrator orders the following;

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the Cook County ETSB request for approval of its modification plan as follows:

Opting out the Village of Stone Park from the Cook County ETSB to the Proviso-Leyden JETSB

pursuant to Section 15.4a of the Emergency Telephone System Act, 50 ILCS 750/15.4a, is hereby approved subject to the requirements of this Order.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Cook County modification will be completed no later than August 1, 2018.


**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Cook County's 9-1-1 System Service Provider will conduct a P.01 Study and if necessary a Traffic Study to determine the number of 9-1-1 trunks required to serve the Cook County ETSB with the departure of Stone Park.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Cook County ETSB will file with the Administrator a Wireless 9-1-1 Plan that removes Stone Park from their current Plan with an effective date no later than August 1, 2018.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Stone Park surcharge payments currently being distributed to the Cook County ETSB shall begin to be distributed to the Proviso-Leyden JETSB as defined in 50 ILCS 750/30 beginning August 1, 2018.

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
