Adding INdigital's MEVO backup platform for both PSAPs. Both PSAPs back each other up and this will provide another layer of backup. Adding INdigital's Texty service that will allow both PSAPs to receive text to 911 calls and also provide the PSAPs with the capability of initiating text calls to outside callers. The move to the new PSAP will begin Feb. 6, 2019, with a plan to be live in the new PSAP by Feb. 8. The Effingham County PSAP will answer and dispatch all 911 and emergency calls during the move.
