<b>Written Notification</b>	Yes <input checked="" type="checkbox"/> No <input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Effingham County provided notification that it is making the following changes to its 911 System:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) Permanently moving the Effingham Police Department PSAP from 201 E Jefferson to 110 S 3<sup>rd</sup> St, Effingham, IL.</li><li>2) Changing CPE to a hosted Solacom 911 call taking system provided by INdigital telecom.</li><li>3) Changing the mapping system for both PSAPs to Solacom Guardian Mapping.</li><li>4) Adding INdigital's MEVO backup platform for both PSAPs. Both PSAPs back each other up and this will provide another layer of backup.</li><li>5) Adding INdigital's Texty service that will allow both PSAPs to receive text to 911 calls and also provide the PSAPs with the capability of initiating text calls to outside callers.</li></ol> <p>The move to the new PSAP will begin Feb. 6, 2019, with a plan to be live in the new PSAP by Feb. 8. The Effingham County PSAP will answer and dispatch all 911 and emergency calls during the move.</p>
