Wireless surcharge will be transferred to the NWC9-1-1 once a wireless plan adding Barrington is filed and approved by the Statewide 9-1-1 Administrator.</p>

Both NWC9-1-1 and CenCom 9-1-1's serving populations will remain above 25,000 in their respective 9-1-1 systems, therefore meeting the requirement to serve a minimum population of at least 25,000 pursuant to Section 15.4a, 2) of the ETSA. This plan modification also meets the requirements for a modified plan filing under Illinois Administrative Code Part 1325.205.
